

Jay Bailey President & CEO, Russell Innovation Center for Entrepreneurs (RICE)



Committed to living by his personal motto, "Build As We Climb", change agent, thought leader, entrepreneur and emerging philanthropist, James M. Bailey has dedicated his life to serving others.

James serves as the President and CEO of the Russell Innovation Center for Entrepreneurs (RICE). A \$50 million dollar endeavor honoring the great legacy and visionary business leadership of Herman J. Russell, Sr., he will lead the development of the largest center in America, dedicated to empowering Black entrepreneurs and small business owners; over 54,000 square feet designed to inspire BIG IDEAS, create jobs, grow companies, and increase wealth in the community.

An Atlanta native and die-hard Georgia Bulldog, James has a proven track record of success, recognized by 3 U.S. Presidents for his leadership and community efforts. In 2012, James was one of eight Americans honored at the White House as a "Champion of Change: Following in the Footsteps of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr."

A National Point of Light Award recipient, James was recently named to the Atlanta Business Chronicle's POWER 100 Most Influential Leaders in the City and Georgia Trend Magazine's, Georgia 500 Most Influential Leaders in the State.

A graduate of Leadership Georgia, Leadership Atlanta, and the Regional Leadership Institute, He is a recipient of the coveted Whitney M. Young National Community Service Medallion, the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drum Major for Service Award, a New Leaders Council Fellow, member of Alpha Phi Alpha and the 100 Black Men of Atlanta.

Bill Connors President, Xfinity



Bill Connors is President of Xfinity for Comcast Cable, the largest broadband and PayTV operator in the United States with over 30 million customers and \$58 billion in revenue. In this role, Bill leads all Comcast's residential execution and competitive strategies around the company's consumer business.

A 39-year veteran of the broadband, cable industry, Bill most recently served as President of Comcast's Central Division, leading residential and business services operations for the company's largest business unit within the Comcast NBCUniversal global assets. He has also served as President of Comcast's Eastern Division and, before that, President of Comcast's Midwest Division.

Previous roles include Senior Vice President of Atlanta Region, Western Region Vice President for theGreater Chicago Market, and General Manager and Director of Customer Operations positions in both Florida and Chicago markets. Bill also served as the Domestic Operations Advisor for the Company's Singapore Broadband venture from 1996 to 1999.

Bill is an active community volunteer, having served in numerous board and advisory board positions with several organizations, including the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, and Special Olympics Foundation. In addition, he has served on national board positions, including the Detroit Renaissance Board, Cranbrook Institute of Science, COMPAC, Comcast SportsNet Chicago, Comcast Sports Southeast Network, and the Comcast Foundation. Bill is also the co-creator and executive sponsor of the Comcast NBCUniversal SportsTech Global accelerator and The Farm accelerator.

He is also a member of numerous industry organizations, including the Society of Cable Telecommunications Engineers (SCTE), Cable and Telecommunications Association for Marketing (CTAM), Women in Cable Telecommunications (WICT) and the National Association for Multi-Ethnicity in Communications (NAMIC).
